You **mustn't** smoke !



**Don't** play in the street .



You **must** look on the left and on the right before crossing the street !



You **must** brush your teeth everyday !





### Must for obligation, mustn't for prohibition

*Must* is a modal verb. You use *must* to talk about something you're obliged or strongly advised to do.

You often use it when you talk about **safety instructions**.

- You *must* fasten your seat belt.

You use *must not, (mustn't)* to talk about something you aren't allowed to do or you're strongly advised not to do.

- You *mustn't* lean out of the window.

## PRONUNCIATION

Many English words have silent letters.

**I:** i(s)land, i(s)les

Ireland is an i(s)land. The British I(s)les are not part of Ireland.

**T:** lis(t)en, fas(t)en, of(t)en, whis(t)le, cas(t)le, Chris(t)mas
