


THE SECOND CONDITIONAL



We use the second conditional when we talk about *imaginary / unrealistic* events. Take a look at the structure below. Note that we can change the order as indicated.



Important note: When we use the second conditional, we use I with were.

Look at the examples:

If I were rich, I would donate a lot of money to charity.

If I were president, I would focus on climate change.


